Think Before You Post

Question 1: No private information, such as our full name, email address, or pictures of your home

Question 2: Everything you do online

Question 3: Forever

Question 4: Why do I want to share this? Where did I get my information from? (Is it correct?)

Will someone be hurt? Would I show my parents?

Question 5: Tell your teacher, parents, or trusted adult

Question 6: Never

Choose Strong Passwords

Question 1: Long words and phrases with numbers and symbols; nothing personal

Question 2: Parents or trusted adult (Not your best friend)

Question 3: One precaution is to logout before leaving

Question 4: Use trusted password managing software or write it down in a notebook

Question 5: Short words that are easy to guess; Your name, birthday, or "Password"

Question 6: It's an extra layer of security to your account in case your password is stolen

Be Careful What You Download

Question 1: They can contain viruses; They can be used to access and steal your information

Question 2: Be wary of unsolicited attachments, even from people you know; Update virus protection; Keep software up to date; Beware of emails from people you don't know

Question 3: There is "HTTPS" at the beginning of the address or a lock symbol

Question 4: The file type; Is the website secured; Is offer too good to be true

Question 5: They can automatically charge you for premium services; They can steal sensitive information; They can make you more susceptible to infections

Question 6: Downloading from unknown sources; Downloading without a virus or spyware scanner

Beware Of Strangers

Question 1: Always be cautious and don't assume anything

Question 2: Notify parents, a trusted adult, or a teacher that you are talking with someone; Never give personal or private information

Question 3: Using fake photos; Lying about their age and who they are; Using voice-altering devices; Using false usernames or email addresses

Question 4: Instant messaging; Email; Video game chats; Social media

Question 5: Try to play with people you know, but don't communicate with strangers
