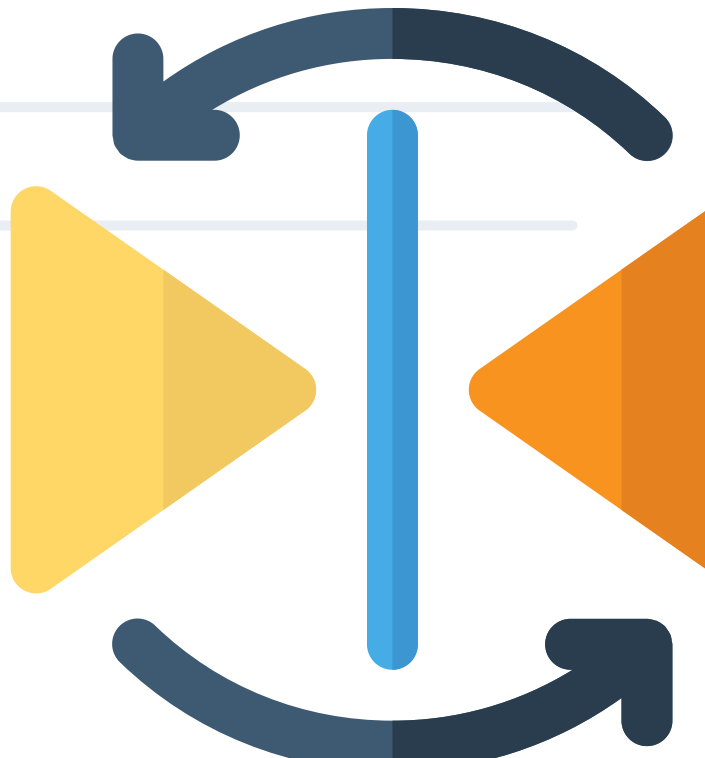




Reflection
